Graduate Advisory Committees

Doctoral candidates must have an Advisory Committee of at least four faculty members with a doctoral degree and at least three of whom must be on the AOE faculty. The Chair of the Advisory Committee must be a teaching/research faculty (full time, tenured or tenure track faculty at Virginia Tech), and ordinarily is a member of the AOE faculty. In special cases with the approval of the Department Head, a member of the Virginia Tech faculty outside of the AOE Department may serve as Advisor. In special cases, which may occur when students are planning to do their research in absentia, highly qualified persons who are not Virginia Tech faculty members may serve as Advisory Committee Members, with approval of the Dean of the Graduate School and the Department Head. These external committee members may not constitute more than one-third of the total Advisory Committee membership and they may not serve as the Advisor (Chairperson). Approval of external committee members requires submission of the Graduate Program Faculty and Additional Graduate Advisory Committee Members Form (http://graduateschool.vt.edu/forms/academics/Grad_Progr_Fac_Addl_Members_05212015.pdf) with a curriculum vitae to the Graduate Program Coordinator prior to the submission of the Plan of Study.
