In order to be eligible for a Robert Noyce Scholarship, you must...

- ☑ Be a U.S. citizen, national, or permanent resident alien
- ☑ Be interested in a career in teaching
- ✓ Hold a degree in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics
- Agree to teach in a high-needs school for two years after graduation
