



»HAW goes USA« Travel Stipends for strategic partners

Hamburg University of Applied Sciences is a long-term strategic partner of Virginia Tech with a special focus on aeronautical engineering. Hamburg is the third largest centre for civil aviation in the world and home to the main Airbus assembly site.

Virginia Tech students can complete their Junior Spring Semester abroad in Hamburg and get credits for the HAW Hamburg classes towards their degree in Blacksburg.

Three 1,000 Euro travel stipends

Due to corona, VT students had to return home in 2020 and exchange was cancelled in 2021. We would really like to help get exchange back on track for Spring 2022, so to help do that we are offering three 1,000 Euro travel stipends to Virginia Tech aeronautical engineering students.

Step 2: Students interested in applying for the travel stipend should submit the following:

- 1. Resumé
- 2. Statement of motivation (1.5 pages), explaining in detail why you want to study at HAW Hamburg, what classes you want to take and why (how do they fit into your curriculum and/or career plans)
- 3. Transcript of record
- 4. Letter of recommendation from a Virginia Tech professor

Application deadline: 1. October 2021
