AOE Track & General Technical Electives

- 18 total technical elective credits are required.
- A maximum of 6 out of the 18 credits may be non-AOE.
- AOE credits have "AOE" in front of the course number (e.g. AOE-4084).
- Non-AOE credits have a different designation in front of the course number (e.g. CS-1064).

Track Technical Electives

9 technical tracks to choose from.

You don't "declare" a track. Just start taking courses for it.

Take 9 credits (3 courses) from one track.

If a track has a foundational course, you must take it. But, you don't have to take it first.

Some courses appear in multiple tracks. DARS will put a course in the first available space until a track is fulfilled.

General Technical Electives

Take 9 general technical elective credits.

These can include any
AOE credits not
counting for another
requirement.

These can include non-AOE credits from the list on the checksheets.

AOE undergrad research & independent study will count.

Keep in mind:

- All technical electives <u>must</u> be taken for A-F credit.
- Minor courses <u>may</u> count as technical electives.
- If a course is required for your major, it does not count as a technical elective.
- You cannot count both CS 1054 & CS 1114.
- Your track is NOT listed on your transcript/diploma.
