## **FAQs of the Month**

# I was unable to enroll in a Math course for Fall 2025, because I plan to take its prerequisite over the summer at a different institution. What should I do?

- To ensure that they will offer enough sections, the Math Department is collecting anticipated enrollment data for their fall courses.
- Their <u>Anticipated Enrollment Survey</u> will be open from April 25th to June 1st. If you were not able to enroll in a fall course due to a prerequisite error, it is important that you fill out this form.
- The <u>Math Department Force Add Survey</u> opens on August 4th. If your summer transfer credit is not processed in time for you to add yourself to the course, request a force-add using this form.

## What is the undergraduate/graduate (UG/G) program? How do I apply?

- The <u>Accelerated Undergraduate / Graduate (UG/G) program</u> allows you to double count 12 credits taken during your senior year for both your undergraduate degree and a graduate degree.
- Find more information about Aerospace Engineering & Ocean Engineering graduate degrees in the Graduate Catalog. Both MS and direct to PHD options are available.
- If you will complete your undergraduate degree in May 2026, apply this spring (for the Fall 2026 term).
- Complete the <u>VT Graduate School Application</u> and submit the <u>Accelerated Undergraduate/Graduate Degree</u> <u>and Course Designation Form</u>. A minimum 3.3 cumulative GPA is required to qualify for this program.

## Who can I ask to be a reference for the UG/G program?

- When applying to the UG/G program, you need three letters of recommendation.
- References for this program can be anyone who knows you in an academic or professional context. Some options include: professors, academic advisors, research mentors, internship supervisors, etc...
- It is good practice to ask for a letter of recommendation at least a month before it is due.
