FAQs of the Month

I'm graduating in May! What important dates/times should I keep in mind for commencement?

- Friday May 10 8:30-11:00 AM: University Commencement, Lane Stadium
- Friday May 10 3:00-5:00 PM: AOE Graduation Celebration, tent in front of Patton Hall
- Friday May 10 7:00-9:00 PM: Corps of Cadets Graduation and Joint Commissioning Ceremony, Burruss Hall
- Saturday May 11 3:30-5:30 PM: College of Engineering Ceremony Three, Cassell Coliseum (this is where graduates walk across the stage)

I'm trying to plan ahead. What do I need to know to select my track technical electives and general technical electives?

- There is an <u>AOE Technical Electives Guide</u>* on the AOE Advising website. Here, you will find an infographic explaining the difference between track technical electives and general technical electives. You will also find examples of technical elective plans that either work or have problems.
- Find descriptions of each track on the <u>AOE curriculum website</u> and in the checksheets.
- AOE sometimes offers special studies/new courses. Look for notes on the timetable to determine if a special study/new course will count in a technical track. Check with your advisor if you have any questions.
- You may only count **6 credits** of non-AOE coursework towards your track/general technical electives.
- Keep in mind that any AOE credits taken in A-F grade mode that are not already counting for another requirement on the checksheet can count as general technical electives. This includes AOE courses from other tracks and AOE undergrad research credits.
- *Special Note: The information in this guide applies to students on the 2020-2021, 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 checksheets. If you are on the 2023-2024 checksheet (i.e. you started at VT this academic year) you have slightly different technical elective requirements, due to the addition of the programming elective. Please refer to your checksheet and check with your academic advisor if you have questions.

My DARS shows courses in 3 different tracks. Why?

• Track/general technical electives may show up under different tracks at first. Once you enroll in 3 courses that fulfill a single track, they should group together, showing that the track is in-progress or complete.
