FAQs of the Month

I heard that I am supposed to "apply for my degree". What does that mean?

- Your "application for degree" tells VT what term you intend to graduate and is VERY important for our graduation clearance process. After you have applied for your degree you can run a <u>DARS report</u>.
- You should <u>apply for your degree</u> in Hokie Spa by fall of junior year. But, there is no harm in applying earlier. You can always change your information later if needed.

What should I course request for Fall 2023?

- Use the AOE checksheets/curriculum resources to determine your appropriate Fall 2022 courses.
- Read the Fall 2023 Course Request Guides on the AOE Advising Website.
- If you have unique circumstances that make your plan differ from the traditional checksheet progression (e.g. 5-year plan, double major, minors, etc.), schedule an advising appointment to discuss your fall plan.

I'm not able to request an AOE course that I need in Fall 2023. Can I be force-added during course request?

- You cannot be force-added during course request.
- During the add/drop periods for Fall 2023, you may submit requests to be force-added to AOE courses, using our online <u>AOE Force-Add Request Form</u>.
- Carefully read the instructions for requesting a force-add and include necessary documentation.

What is the undergraduate/graduate (UG/G) program? How do I apply?

- The <u>Accelerated Undergraduate / Graduate (UG/G) program</u> allows you to double count 12 credits taken during your senior year for both your undergraduate degree and a graduate degree.
- Find more information about <u>Aerospace Engineering</u> & <u>Ocean Engineering</u> graduate degrees in the Graduate Catalog. Both MS and direct to PHD options are available.
- If you will complete your undergraduate degree in May 2024, apply this spring (for the Fall 2024 term).
- In addition to the VT grad program application, submit an <u>Accelerated Undergraduate/Graduate Degree</u> <u>and Course Designation Form</u>.
- A minimum 3.3 GPA is required to qualify.
