# **FAQs of the Month**

### What should I course request for Fall 2024?

- Use the AOE checksheets/curriculum resources to determine your appropriate Fall 2024 courses.
- Read the Fall 2024 Course Request Guides on the AOE Advising Website.
- If you have unique circumstances that make your plan differ from the traditional checksheet progression (e.g. 5-year plan, double major, minors, transfer student, etc.), schedule an advising appointment to discuss your fall plan.

# I'm not able to request an AOE course that I need in Fall 2024. Can I be forceadded during course request?

- You cannot be force-added during course request.
- During the add/drop periods for Fall 2023, you may submit requests to be force-added to AOE courses, using our online <u>AOE Force-Add Request Form</u>.
- Carefully read the instructions for requesting a force-add and include necessary documentation.

## What is the undergraduate/graduate (UG/G) program? How do I apply?

- The <u>Accelerated Undergraduate / Graduate (UG/G) program</u> allows you to double count 12 credits taken during your senior year for both your undergraduate degree and a graduate degree.
- Find more information about <u>Aerospace Engineering</u> & <u>Ocean Engineering</u> graduate degrees in the Graduate Catalog. Both MS and direct to PHD options are available.
- If you will complete your undergraduate degree in May 2025, apply this spring (for the Fall 2025 term).
- In addition to the VT grad program application, submit an <u>Accelerated Undergraduate/Graduate Degree and Course Designation Form.</u>
- A minimum 3.3 GPA is required to qualify.

### Where can I get extra help in math courses?
