VT Academic Calendar

- 1. I am enrolled in one summer course at VT. but no longer want to take it. How do I drop the course?
 - \succ Students are not able to drop their final credits for a term through Hokie Spa. To drop all of your enrolled summer credits, use the withdrawal/resignation form. Follow the instructions for how to fill out/submit the form.
- 2. I want to take courses at a different college/university this summer. What should I do?
 - > Read & follow the COE instructions/requirements for Transferrable Credits from other Universities.
 - ➤ For a VCCS course, use the VCCS Guide to determine the equivalent course. Non-VCCS courses must be pre-approved using COE's Authorization to Take Courses Elsewhere form.
 - ➢ If the transfer course is a prerequisite for a FA 2021 AOE course, request a force-add once you have your final grade (must be a C or higher).
- 3. What can I do this summer to make the start of the Fall 2021 Semester easier?
 - Create/update a long-term degree plan for yourself. If you have questions about your long-term plan or Fall 2021 courses, schedule a summer Zoom appointment with your advisor through Navigate.
 - > Apply for your degree. Then, run a DARS report and check with your advisor if you have questions about your progress towards degree requirements.
 - > Update your resume. Get resume tips and career advising from Career & Professional Development. Remember that design team recruitment and career fairs begin early in the semester.
