FAQs of the Month

- 1. Is tutoring available for my courses?
 - ➤ Find tutoring resources relevant to AOE students on the AOE Tutoring & Academic Support web page.
 - The AOE chapter of Sigma Gamma Tau (SGT) is now offering tutoring for select AOE courses. Fill out the <u>SGT Tutoring Sign-Up Form</u>, to be connected with an SGT tutor.
 - ➤ The <u>Student Success Center</u> and some other departments offer tutoring for a variety of courses.
 - > Also, remember to make use of office hours with your professors/TAs.
- 2. What should I do to prepare for and complete Spring 2022 course request?
 - Complete course request at any time during the window (there is no benefit to being early). But, don't wait until the last day when the system may be slower due to high activity.
 - You cannot be force-added to courses during course request.
 - ➤ Watch this <u>How to Complete Course Request</u> video from Engineering Education.
 - > Run a DARS to see which courses you have already completed/which are missing.
 - Review the <u>checksheet</u> for your year/major. Most students should follow the checksheet exactly when making course requests.
 - ➤ If you have a less common situation (e.g. transfer student, behind/ahead with required courses), check in with your advisor to review your plan.
 - Seniors: pay attention to technical/track elective requirements. Make sure you are selecting spring courses that will complete your requirements.
 - If you have any questions, check with your advisor!
