### FAQs of the Month

- 1. I want to take courses at a different college/university this summer. What should I do?**
  - Follow the COE instructions/requirements for [Transferrable Credits from other Universities](#).
  - For a VCCS course, use the [VCCS Guide](#) to determine the equivalent course. Non-VCCS courses must be pre-approved using COE's [Authorization to Take Courses Elsewhere](#) form.
  - If the transfer course is a prerequisite for a FA 2021 AOE course, request a [force-add](#) once you have your final grade (must be a C or higher).
- 2. What is the undergraduate/graduate (UG/G) program (accelerated masters)? How do I apply?**
  - The [Accelerated Undergraduate / Graduate \(UG/G\) program](#) allows you to double count 12 credits taken during your senior year for both your undergraduate degree and a graduate degree.
  - Find more information about [Aerospace Engineering & Ocean Engineering](#) graduate degrees in the Graduate Catalog.
  - If you will complete your undergraduate degree in May 2023, [apply](#) this spring ([for the Fall 2023 term](#)).
  - In addition to the VT grad program application, submit an [Accelerated UG/G form](#).
  - The GRE is not required.
  - A minimum 3.3 GPA is required to qualify.
- 4. How do I add 5000-level courses if I am in UG/G?**
  - Even if you have been accepted to UG/G, you will not be able to add 5000-level courses yourself.
  - Work with the [graduate program coordinators](#) to be force-added to necessary 5000-level courses after acceptance to the program.
